




### EMERALD HEIGHTS MODEL UNITED NATIONS (EHMUN)



### GLOBAL EDUCATION BENCHMARK GROUP'S STUDENTS DIALOGUE SERIES


'Imagine a world where everyone is really a Changemaker,' - Bill Drayton.

The students were asked to dress themselves in such a way which reflected their cultural identity and bring the colors of diversity to the event. The students also reflected on the meanings of their names and its origin.







Now with a fall in cases, they have shifted their focus in facilitating supply of blood to patients of Thalassemia and people undergoing surgery.


The group has made uncountable blood donations so far and have actively been organizing blood donation camps throughout the city.
