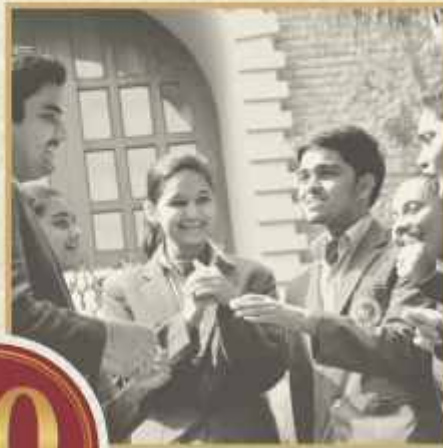
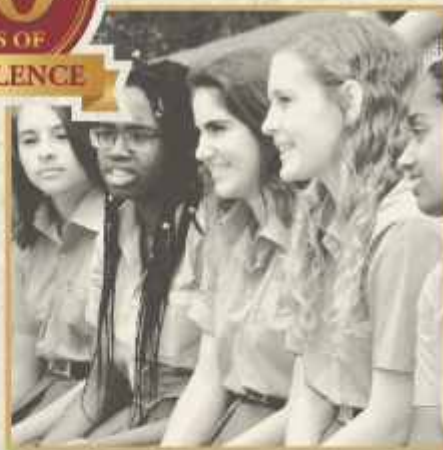

## AFS TREE PLANTATION DRIVE

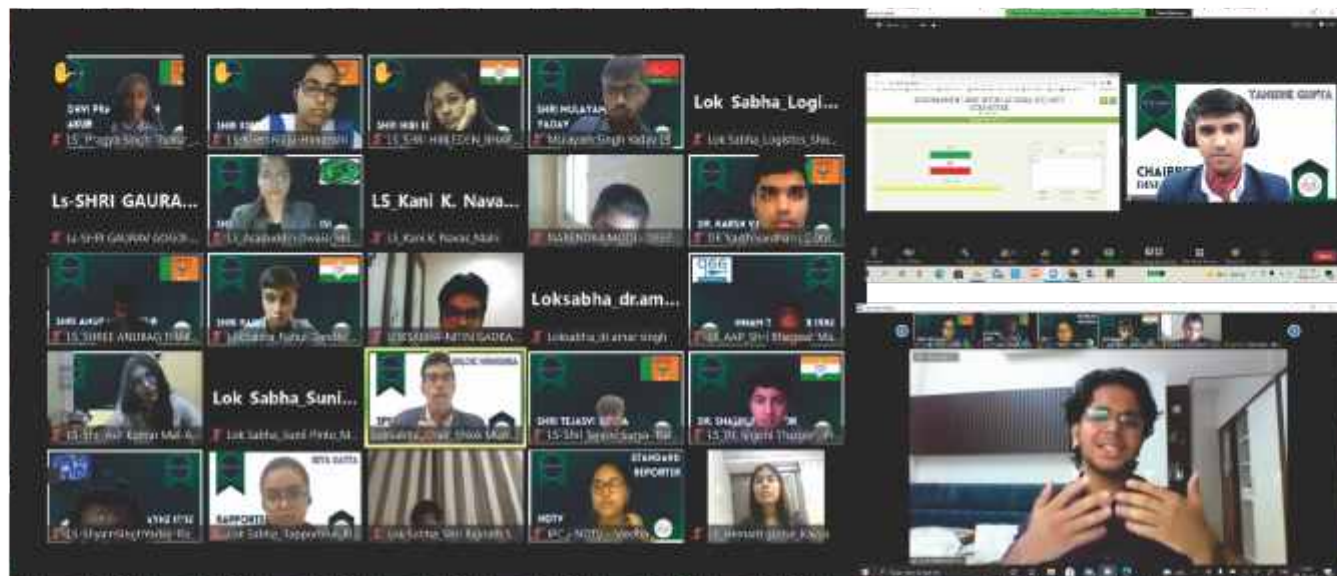

## GLOBAL EDUCATION BENCHMARK GROUP'S STUDENTS DIALOGUE SERIES

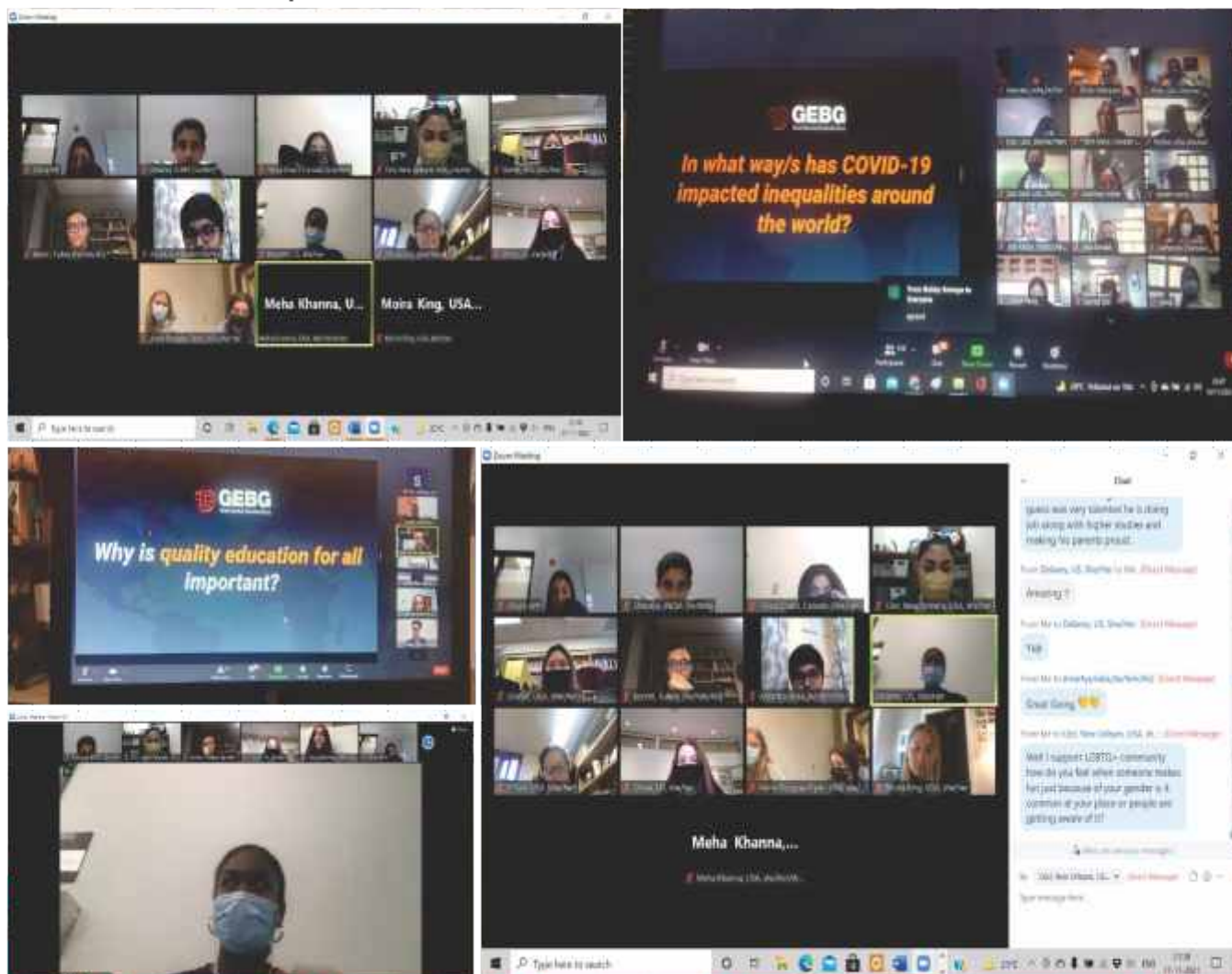

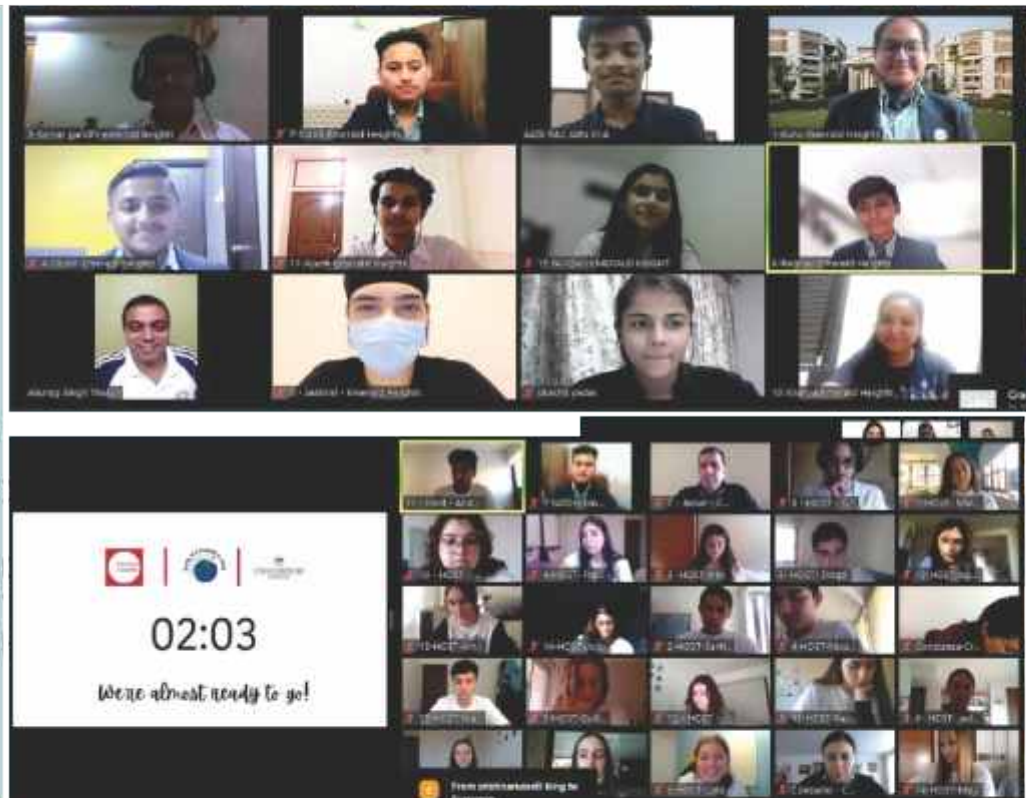

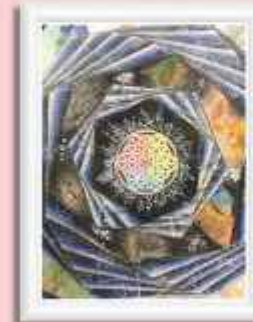

The emphasis seems to be on critical reading, analysis, or a particular and a certain theme.

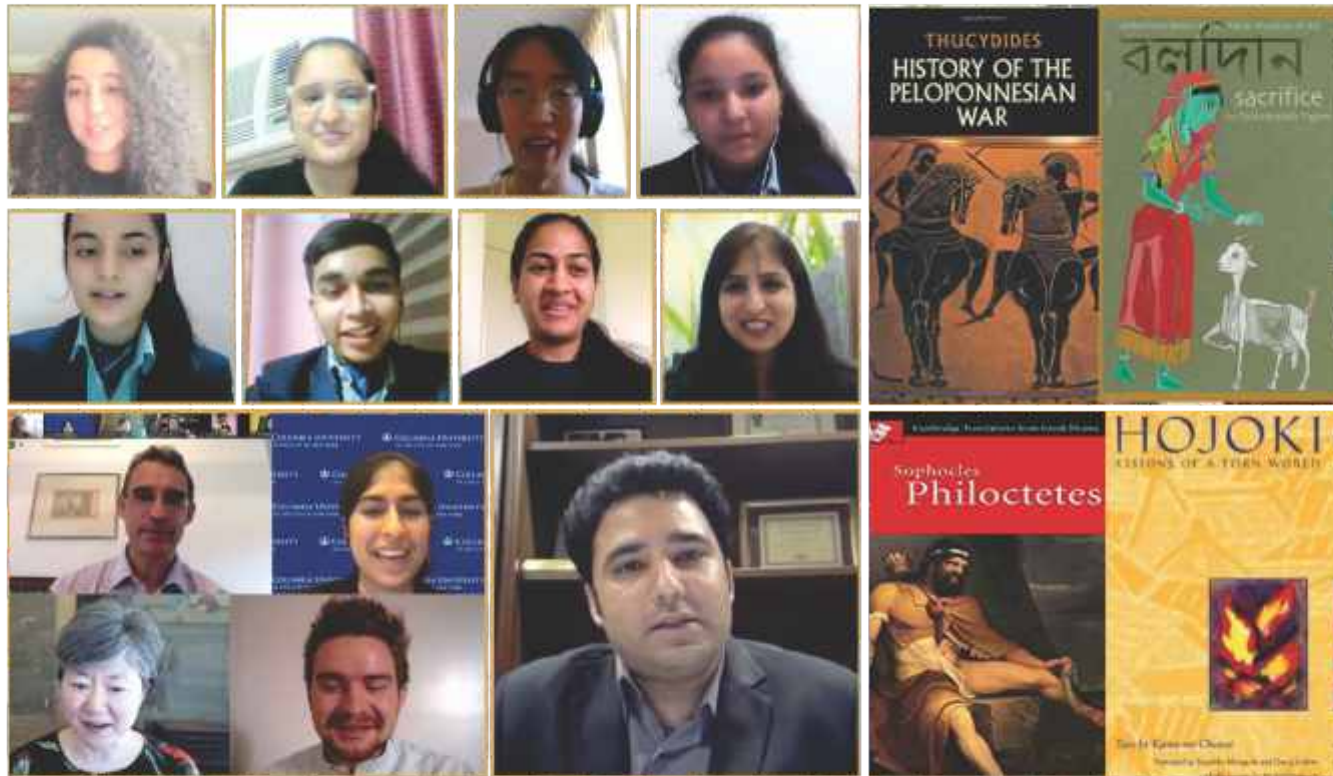
If we understand the work of description, break it down and teach it in its progressively more and more complex functions, will it make it possible to:

- 1) teach attentive reading and writing?
- 2) make the work of analysis easier to approach and teach?

#### Academics / Experimental Sciences

- College students are able to "say what is not" - accurate summary and reading comprehension skills are crucial in this
- Students are guided to how they approach to the text thus are reading and like over to what they think it means based on what they think it says.
- A professional I have observed in the 2018-2019 school, in first-year writing classes in well-learned advanced courses at the undergraduate and post-graduate level, teaches an old lesson: attention to the use of form of story. (Sometimes this can be seen in the writing of published science.)
- Agnes Fritzsche - form, race, representation, looking out (words) and in (text) without checking for whether it tells more in what it has to say, but of rigor in academic work.

We are grateful to Flame University for bringing this wonderful initiative for our students.





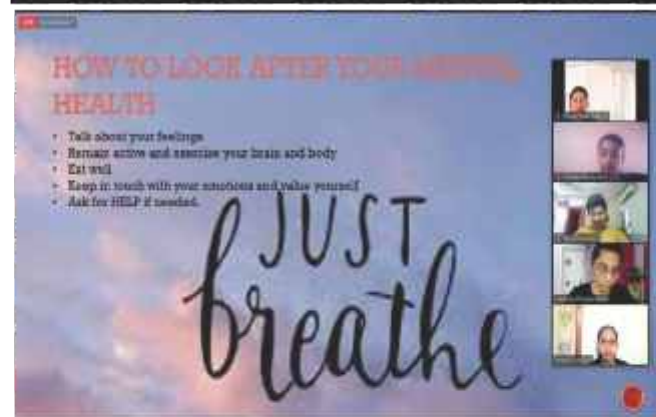
