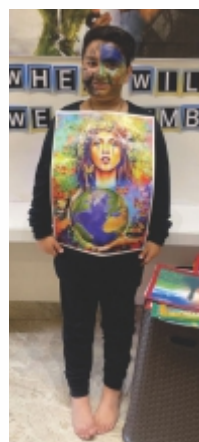

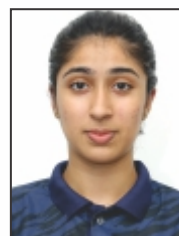
### INTERNATIONAL DEBATER- AVNI KAUR CHADHA
