## INTERNATIONAL ACHIEVERS

### SBKF 8TH INTERNATIONAL GAMES 2023

Emeralite Sanidhya Goud of Class-XII brought laurels to the country by bagging 3 Gold medals and the award for Best Player (Fastest Swimmer of the Tournament) in Swimming at SBKF 8th International Games 2023, organized by Sanyukta Bhartiya Khel Foundation (SBKF) at Dubai, UAE. Sanidhya received a cash prize of ₹2,00,000 which he has donated to a Cancer Foundation in Bhopal. Sanidhya Goud bagged 3 Gold Medals in Swimming at SBKF 8th National Games 2023, organized by Sanyukta Bhartiya Khel Foundation (SBKF), held at Talkatora Stadium, New Delhi.



### INDO-NEPAL MIXED NETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

I hope you are well. I am writing to give you an update on Team India's performance at AWSDC 2023 in Bangkok and WSDC 2023 in Hanoi. It is with great pleasure that I wish to inform you that the team performed excellently at both competitions! At AWSDC 2023, Team India finished as Grand-finalists, dropping a debate on a close, 5-4 split decision to Team China in the Grand Final. At this competition, the team faced and defeated national teams from the Philippines, Canada, Australia, among others. At WSDC 2023, Team India was top ranked at the end of the preliminary rounds, breaking first. They were the only team of 64 nations to have won all 8 of their preliminary rounds, defeating teams from the UAE, Latvia, Mexico, Hong Kong, Scotland, Sri Lanka, China, and the US. Following this, they proceeded to win their Octofinal, and finished at the competition as Quarterfinalists, where they dropped the debate to Team Scotland on a close, 4-3 split decision. These achievements were in no small part due to Avni's contributions – she was integral to the team's success, and we had a great time working with her through this year, in addition to the last two years that has shaped her trajectory. As an individual speaker, she ranked in the top 10 speakers in the World this year (6th) at WSDC, and in the top 10 at AWSDC (9th), an incredible achievement that speaks to her talent and hard work. We also wanted to pass on a note of thanks to Emerald Heights International School for your support over the years, and in particular for giving Avni extended time off for AWSDC and WSDC this year. ISDS would not be able to experience these successes without supportive schools. We look forward to identifying and working with more talented students from your school in future years, and to seeing your students achieve greater successes in school and beyond!

### TAVNEET SINGH MUNDRA: SQUASH PLAYER

Our ace squash player, Tavneet Singh Mundra of Class-XII brought laurels to the state by bagging medals in the following prestigious tournaments of the country-

#### Khelo India Youth Games 2024 (KIYG2024)

Tavneet Singh Mundra bagged Gold medal for Madhya Pradesh in Squash (Boys U-19) at the Khelo India Youth Games 2024 (KIYG2024), held at Indian Squash & Triathlon Academy, Chennai, Tamil Nadu from 20-24 January, 2024. There were more than 5600 athletes from thirty-six states and UT participated in the KIYG2024.

Squash made its debut in this 6th edition of Khelo India Youth Games.

#### 37th National Games of India

Madhya Pradesh's Squash Team bagged Bronze Medal at the 37th National Games of India, held at Goa from 25 October to 9 November 2023 wherein more than 10,000 players from 28 states and 8 Union Territories competing across 43 sporting events. Tavneet Singh Mundra led the Squash Team of Madhya Pradesh as a Captain in this prestigious event, which is held biennially.

Jiya Saraf of Class-XII: Bronze Medal in Above 78Kg Junior category

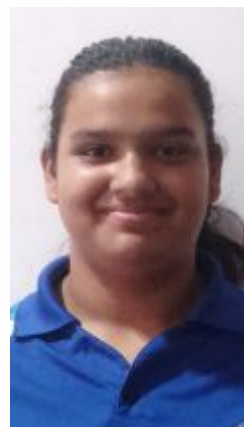
Shailee and Jiya received a cash prize of ₹2000 each.

Shailee Gupta represented Madhya Pradesh in 70Kg weight category at the 6th edition of Khelo India Youth Games.

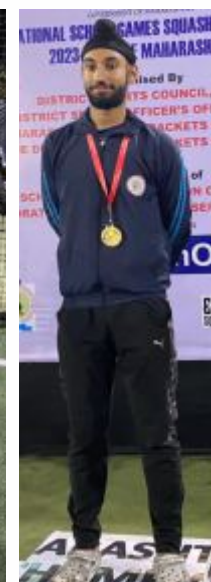


### 67TH SGFI NATIONAL SCHOOL GAMES SQUASH CHAMPIONSHIP 2023-24

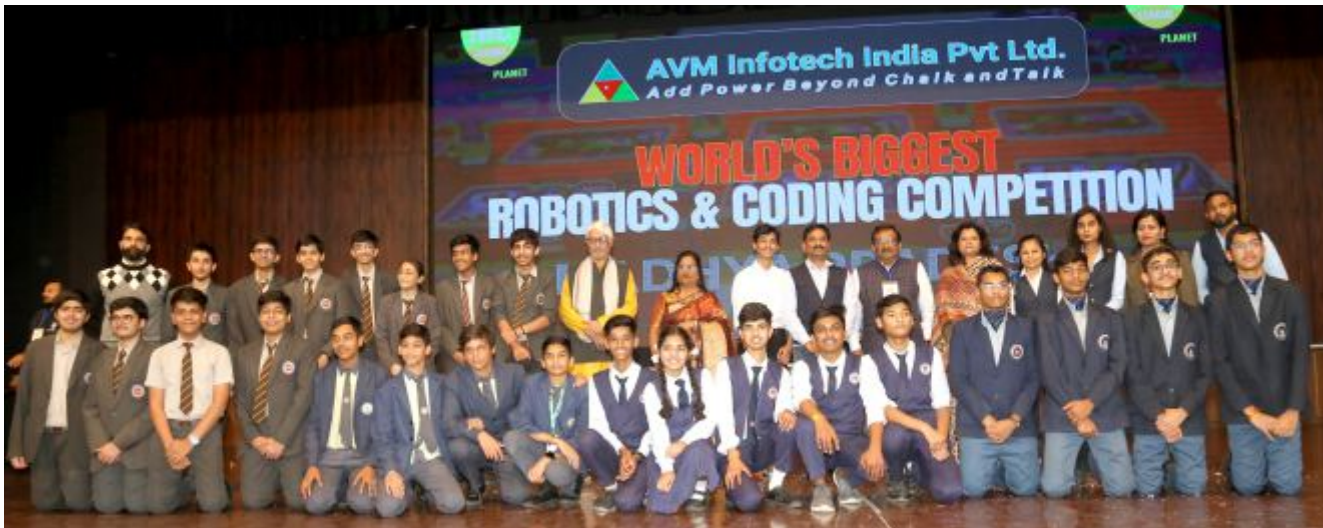


## AVISHKAAR'S IRC ZONAL CHALLENGE 2023

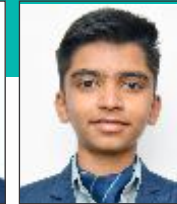
